Holding Our Original Confidence	
The Two Opposite Realities	
Please note the mind of the Spirit. Two opposite realities	s are taught in this passage:
 "An evil, unbelieving heart;" and in contrast, "Our original confidence firm to the end."

What happened? The diagnosis of the Holy Spirit is this: They were "hardened by the deceitfulness of sin." So, notice again the downward spiral:

Expressed faith in Christ

→ tricked by sin's pleasure

→ hard, unbelieving heart; and

 \Rightarrow then we hear these horrible words: "fall[ing] away from the living God." 2

Sanctification, growth in holiness is a community project. It takes a church to grow a Christian. I don't have to meet together with Christians to be a Christian; but I can't be one without it.
